2025

The years 2024 and 2025 have represented one of the most complex humanitarian and spiritual seasons in Cuba's recent history. Severe economic collapse, ongoing fuel and energy shortages, food scarcity, epidemics, and mass emigration have created unprecedented challenges across the nation.

Despite these conditions, , the church in Cuba is not shrinking; it is growing and flourishing.

Our ministry has been honored to stand alongside pastors, leaders, and believers throughout the nation—serving, training, and equipping them to bring hope to their communities.

We firmly believe that Cuba is a hidden treasure, now being uncovered by the hand of God.

This report outlines the measurable impact achieved in 2025 and presents the ongoing vision that donor partnership is helping to make possible.



Impartation



National Ministry Reach

Through coordinated ministry trips, leadership conferences, and nationwide initiatives, the ministry achieved the following outcomes:

Reached over 30,000 pastors and leaders across Cuba through more than 40 conferences and gatherings.



Ministered to 8,000+ pastors and leaders and 2,700 young people in every province of the nation.

- Impacted nearly 50,000 people with food during events, conferences, and outreach initiatives.
- Helped 500+ families through food distribution, medical aid, and spiritual care.
- Supported 80 pastors, 10 missionaries, and 10 church planters on a consistent basis.
- Blessed 400+ individuals with direct financial offerings.

Today, it is nearly impossible to gather fewer than 900 people at our meetings—clear evidence of a powerful move of God sweeping the nation.

Building and Planting the Church

We are witnessing tangible transformation across Cuba:

- 33 new churches planted in 2025.
- 12 new mission fields opened, each with the potential to become an established church in 2026.
- 4 pastoral homes under construction, each including a designated place of worship.
- Multiple church properties purchased for new congregations and leadership training centers.
- A new Apostolic Sending Center established to train, equip, and release leaders across the nation.



Our long-term dream is to acquire a permanent ministry center—a hub to train leaders, host visiting teams, and generate sustainable income to support the ministry long-term.

Meeting Physical Needs

In partnership with local churches, leaders, and medical professionals, we have responded to the urgent humanitarian crisis:



- Purchased and distributed tens of thousands of pounds of rice.
 - Provided over 30,000 pounds of rice specifically to pastors, missionaries, and families in need.
 - Sent 100 food packages (combos) to vulnerable communities.
 - Helped 50+ families with home reconstruction and repairs.
 - Distributed nearly 5,000 pounds of medicine, totaling over 3,000+ pounds of medical and humanitarian aid throughout the year.

We also established Cuba's first church-led food pantry, which:

- Feeds the poor every Thursday.
- Provides medicine to the sick.

Through these acts of compassion, the church has become the true "House of Bread"—the hands of Jesus extended to its communities.



Raising a New Generation

We are deeply committed to empowering the next generation of leaders:

- Hosted a 4-day youth camp in Havana and Matanzas for 300 young people, fully providing food, lodging, and transportation.
- Launched our Christian university, with:
 - 300 students currently enrolled, and
 - 1,500 students on the waiting list for next year.
- Established 10 small businesses to help pastors and churches move toward financial sustainability.

Our vision is a nationwide network of leaders across all provinces, with regional ambassadors already serving in five key regions of Cuba.

Caring for the Vulnerable

One of the most impactful milestones this year has been the adoption of an orphanage housing 15 children.

After being abandoned by the government, the Kingdom of God stepped in.

We now provide:

- Meals twice a week (with a goal of feeding them daily).
- Clothing, school supplies, and comprehensive care.
- Ongoing spiritual covering through a connected local church.
